## **BUCKEYE INSTITUTE FEBRUARY DATA SEARCH REPORT**

March 7, 2011—COLUMBUS, Ohio - The Buckeye Institute for Public Policy Solutions released the top data searches from the Teacher Salary, State Salary, Federal Salary and Higher Ed Salary databases for February 2011.
