BUCKEYE INSTITUTE MARCH DATA SEARCH REPORT

April 5, 2011, COLUMBUS, Ohio - The Buckeye Institute for Public Policy Solutions released the top data searches from the Teacher Salary, State Salary, Federal Salary and Higher Ed Salary databases for March 2011.

Since the launch of the updated website on April 30, 2010, over 375,000 visitors, 46% who were first time users, from 524 Ohio cities have done over 2,500,000 searches using the searchable data tools. The top searches for March 2011 are as follows:
