Private Sector 1990-2000: 714,400 (17%) | Rank: 37
Government 1990-2000: 63,700 (8.9%)
Private Sector 1990-June 2011: 215,400 (5.2%) | Rank: 46 – CT, MI, RI, NJ & NY worse
Government 1990-June 2011: 48,600 (6.8%)

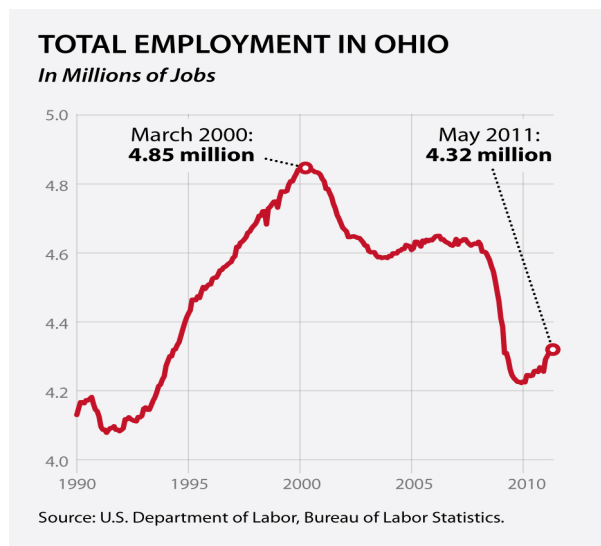

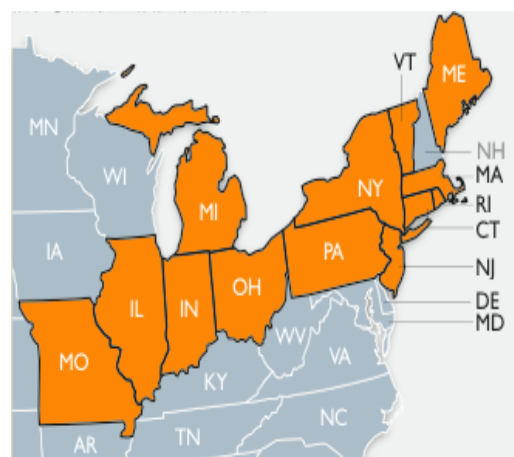
