

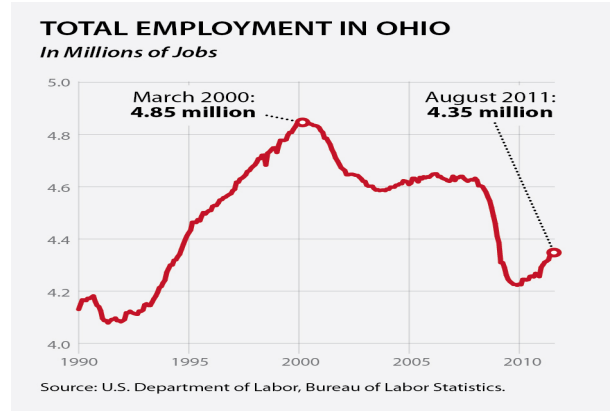
The Buckeye Institute Ohio By Numbers (September 2011)

Private Sector Jobs Recovery

March 2000 (Peak) = 4.85 million jobs
Best Case Recovery: December 2016 (lost one month)
Likely Recovery: Early 2020s

Job Gains/Losses since January 1990

Government 1990-2000: 63,700 (8.9%)
Private Sector 1990-2000: 714,400 (17%) | Rank: 37
Government 2000-2010: 3,700 (0.5%)
Private Sector 2000-2010: -614,300 (-12.7%) | Rank: 50 – only MI worse at -787,400 (-19.7%)
Government 2010-September 2011: -12,300 (-1.6%)
Private Sector 2010-September 2011: 100,300 (2.4%) | Rank: 18–Top 8: ND, TX, UT, OK, LA, VT, AK, WY
Government 1990-September 2011: 55,100 (7.7%)
Private Sector 1990-September 2011: 200,400 (4.9%) | Rank: 47 – only NJ, MI, RI and CT worse

Forced Unionization vs. Worker Freedom

Net Job Gain 1990-2000: 9,162,600 vs. 9,613,800
Percent Growth 1990-2000: 16% vs. 31%

Net Job Loss/Gain 2000-2010: -3,539,500 vs. 454,500
Percent Growth 2000-2010: -5.2% vs. 1.1%

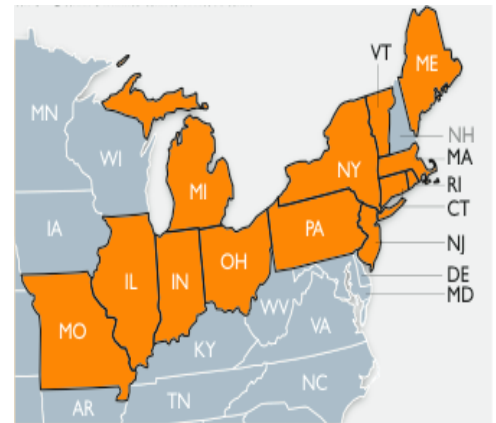
Net Job Gain 2010-2011: 1,391,100 vs. 1,021,900
Percent Growth 2010-2011: 2.1% vs. 2.5%

Net Job Gain 1990-September 2011: 7,014,200 vs. 11,090,200
Percent Growth 1990-2011: 12% vs. 35%

Top 5: all right to work – NV: 81.2%; UT: 79.4%; AZ: 66.0%; ID: 64.9%, ND: 62.7%
