Re: Public Records Request

Dear Custodian of Records:

Pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code § 149.43, The Buckeye Institute respectfully requests that you provide the public records outlined below.

For the purposes of these requests, “document” means any and all information in tangible form, of any nature whatsoever, including the originals and all non-identical copies thereof, in your possession, custody, or control, including all letters, emails, correspondence, text messages, contracts, drafts, agreements, notes to files, reports, memoranda, mechanical and electronic recordings, tapes, or transcripts, information stored in computers or other data storage or processing equipment translated or translatable into a usable form. The term “document” also includes reports, surveys, data, or other information available on any vendor platform or other electronic platform. This request does not seek direct access to such platform.

The terms “relate,” “relating,” or “relative to,” as used herein, shall mean referring to, relating to, embodying, connected with, commenting on, responding to, supporting, showing, describing, analyzing, discussing, reflecting, or constituting.

Unless otherwise provided, for each request, please provide responsive documents for January 1, 2022, to the present. These requests do not seek student names or student personal identifying information.

Please provide copies of the following:

1. **Internships, etc.** All documents relating to any internship, externship, fellowship, or any other job opportunity offered, sponsored, advertised, or supported by the Law School that is offered exclusively to, or that gives a preference to minority or underrepresented students or is otherwise based on race, color, or nationality.
2. **Scholarships.** All documents relating to any scholarship offered, sponsored, advertised, or supported by the Law School that is offered exclusively to, or that gives a preference to minority or underrepresented students or is otherwise based on race, color, or nationality.

3. All documents relating to the Law School giving a preference or priority to minority or underrepresented students or other students based on color, race, or nationality.
4. All e-mails sent to or from Lee Fisher, Dean; Barbara Andelman, Assistant Dean for JD Admissions; John Bell, Assistant Director for JD Admissions; Jessica Pringle, Assistant Director for Outreach & Operations; Sarah D. Beznoska, Assistant Dean for Student and Career Services; Jaime Gay, Assistant Director for Student and Career Services; Lajuan Flores, Director and Title IX Coordinator; Alice F. Jones, Associate Director and Deputy Title IX Coordinator; Carolyn Broering-Jacobs, Associate Dean for Academic & Student Affairs; and Matthew W. Green and Reginal C. Oh, Co-Directors Justice, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion relating to requests 1 through 3.

Please advise if you would prefer to upload the documents to a Dropbox folder. If you need to send hard copies, please send them to the address set forth below, Attn: Alex Certo. If it is not possible to provide the records in electronic format and **if you anticipate that you will incur more than \$50 in copying or scanning expenses, please contact me before incurring these costs.**

If you anticipate a delay longer than ten (10) days, please notify me when you expect the materials to be ready. Failure to promptly produce the requested records may result in legal action, including a request for attorney's fees and damages. *State ex rel. School Choice Ohio, Inc. v. Cincinnati Pub. School Dist.*, 147 Ohio St.3d 256, 2016-Ohio-5026, 63 N.E.3d 1183, ¶ 46.
