SUMMARY OF ACHIEVEMENT

Since 2016, The Buckeye Institute has led the effort in Ohio to cut needless and burdensome regulations. Ohio has become a national leader in removing regulatory barriers to prosperity by adopting Buckeye-championed and inspired recommendations. The result of Buckeye's work is the elimination of ineffective, inefficient, and onerous regulatory requirements on workers and employers that stand in the way of job creation and economic growth and make it harder for workers to start new careers and earn promotions.
