### 1 End Taxpayer-Funded Subsidies

Subsidies give taxpayer dollars to government-favored entities, reducing competition, shrinking energy supplies, and increasing energy costs.

### 2 Safeguard Energy Reliability and Affordability

Policies must ensure that electricity is affordable and available when Ohioans need it.

### 3 Streamline Permitting Processes

Policies at the federal, state, and local levels must focus on bringing powerplants and transmission lines online more quickly.

### 4 End Government-Imposed Mandates

Government regulators do not have the authority to impose de facto mandates on Ohioans.

### 5 Ensure Abundant Energy for Prosperity

Affordable, abundant energy is necessary for businesses to operate and expand, and for the growth of Ohio's high-tech sector.

### 6 Promote Transparency

Policymakers should ensure energy companies are transparent about transmission line capacity to encourage businesses to locate in areas with fewer capacity constraints.
